

Temporary Road Closure Order Town Police Clauses Act 1847

IN ACCORDANCE with Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, which section gives Wiltshire Council ("the Council") the power to make an Order for roads within its administrative area to be closed temporarily to all vehicular traffic (and for alternative routes to be observed) for the purposes of preventing obstruction.

The Council **HEREBY ORDERS**

On: **Saturday 16th June 2018** between the hours of **13.00** and **13.30**

Purpose: **The Winterslow School and Community Summer Fair Procession**


That the following roads and streets in the parish of **Winterslow** are to be closed (save in case of emergency) to all vehicular traffic:

- a) **Gunville Hill**; from its junction with Tytherley Road to its junction with Gunville Road;
- b) **Gunville Road**; from its junction with Gunville Hill to its junction with The Common;
- c) **The Common**; from its junction with Gunville Road to its junction with Middleton Road;
- d) **Middleton Road**; from its junction with The Common to its junction with Middleton.

Nothing in this Order shall prevent vehicles from proceeding in the said lengths of road when being used in connection with the event stated above.

AND it is also hereby ordered that appropriately sign posted diversionary routes will be in place throughout the period of closure.
